










Background

- ► Derived from the Strategic Plan for the Development of the Higher Education System, the prospective strategy for sustainable human development:
 - Create an evaluation center for labor competencies ...
 - Increase the number of technical and technological careers ...
 - ▶ Implement academic programs (blended-learning, online) ...
 - Develop a higher education Labor Information System, creating a Labor Observatory ...
 - Create a prospective unit for sustainable human development that can generate research programs and development, innovation, entrepreneurship (R&D+i+e) (knowledge management).
- Convergence processes focused on non-formal and informal learning: it has highlighted the importance of design and implementation of components for nonformal and informal learning in the education system and recognition of competences and learning acquired throughout lifespan and labor experience.










